

Bellevue Wine Estate, established in 1701, is located in the prestigious Stellenbosch wine growing region of South Africa. The first Pinotage plantings made their way onto Bellevue soil in the early 1950's. Through the utmost care over time, the 1953 Pinotage block is still in production today, as one of the oldest commercially farmed Pinotage vineyards in the world.
